# **APRIL 2024 NEWSLETTER**

Dear Parent/Guardian

We have come to the end of term successfully and we are grateful to God for bringing us this far. I would like to thank you most sincerely for your support and for choosing Nyandarua National Polytechnic to equip your son/daughter with skills for empowerment. Our commitment to provide quality services as guided by our quality policy remains. I wish to highlight the following issues:

#### CONTINUATION OF TRAINING

As you are aware, the MoE has directed that training in TVET institutions should continue throughout the year without designated breaks. Consequently, the polytechnic will be operating on a trimester basis comprising of three semesters. The second semester for the 2024 academic year begins on 29<sup>th</sup> April 2024. **All** continuing trainees are expected to register for the new semester as from this date, through the registrar's office or online and not later than Monday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2024. Any Trainee who fails to register by this date will be deemed to have deferred their studies and will be required to make an official application for deferment. Training and learning will start on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2024. New Trainees are expected to report on **Wednesday**, **8<sup>th</sup> May 2024** and **Friday**, **10<sup>th</sup> May 2024** 

# **COMPETENCY BASED EDUCATION AND TRAINING (CBET)**

The Technical Vocational and Technical Training sector has been undergoing reforms since 2008. The reforms were informed by the challenges that the sector was undergoing then, among them being skills gap arising from the fact that TVET graduates were products of a curriculum that was theory based, with a summative assessment process. The TVET system continued to release graduates that were not consistent with the needs of the industry. Therefore, there was need to fully implement a competence-based education and training (CBET) curriculum that would remedy the skills gap and provide graduates with relevant skills for the industry.

Competency Based Education and Training (CBET) is an educational system that emphasizes the specification, learning and demonstration of the skills and knowledge that are central to a given career, activity or task. CBET emphasizes industry-driven expectations, learner-centred teaching and learning, and learner demonstration of the required vocational skills and knowledge.

In the ongoing reforms, National Polytechnics were set aside as Qualification Awarding Institutions (QAI) meaning that Nyandarua National Polytechnic can develop CBET curricular, train, assess and certify qualifications. Currently as a Polytechnic we have developed our own 28 CBET programs for which the curriculum has been approved by regulatory bodies including TVETA and KNQA.

In September 2023, the GoK through the Ministry of Education directed that all TVET institutions in Kenya should be implementing CBET programs to be assessed by QAIs TVET-CDACC.

The implementation of the CBET curriculum requires the maintenance of a Portfolio of Evidence (PoE) which is a record of the trainee learning progress also known as Formative assessment. It will also require the use of instructional guides and workbooks all of which will require printing.

Consequently, parents and guardians are advised to provide 2 reams of photocopying papers (JK) for this purpose, 1 spring file and 1 portfolio of evidence album, and this applies to *CBET trainees only*. It is important for all students to bring all other departmental training materials as guided by their respective departments.

The trainees who are under KNEC and other programs will continue as scheduled until they complete their courses.

#### **FEES PAYMENT**

I would like to thank most of you for meeting your obligations in fees payment. This has contributed greatly to our being able to improve the learning environment for the trainees and trainers. However, some trainees have some fees arrears and this has slowed our operations. I wish to draw your attention to the **New Government Education Funding Model.** This affected all the trainees who joined as from September and any other intake moving forward. For the continuing trainees they will continue with the old model. The government provides educational loans through the Higher Education Loans Boards (HELB), Please encourage your sons and daughters to take advantage of this fund to ensure that they do not accumulate fees arrears. All trainees are eligible for this loan. Parents are also advised to explore all other possible sources though CDF and SCHOLARSHIPS to minimize training disruptions due to fees arrears.

All parents/guardians are advised to pay institutional fees in time to avoid un necessary inconveniences. However, all the fees arrears should be cleared before the proceeding term.

Kindly note that, Parents/Guardian can pay the specified terms fee in installments after clearing the arrears as follows;

- 1. **50%** on admission/reporting during the first month of the term.
- 2. 30% on or before 10<sup>th</sup> day of the 2<sup>nd</sup> month of the term.

- 3. Clear the remaining balance of 20% on or before 10<sup>th</sup> day of the third month to enable the trainee to generate the exam card.
- 4. No trainee will be allowed to sit for end of term examinations, register for Knec examinations or attend classes without clearing the arrears and paying the required fees instalments as guided above. The fees structure and a copy of this newsletter can be accessed through the trainees' portal, parents phones (through the link provided) and from the polytechnic's website. Fees should be deposited in the Polytechnic's bank account at Nyandarua NationalPolytechinic Equity Bank Nyahururu branch Account No. 0160296471157, Bank slips should then be presented to the accounts office for issuance of a receipt.

Please check regularly when the HELB portal is opened.

#### **EXAMINATIONS AND ASSESSMENT FOR TERM 1 2024**

This term we had both internal and external examinations. They were administered in strict adherence to the standards and procedures provided in the academic policy and our quality standards manual. Parent/guardian are encouraged to discuss the term 1 results with their son / daughter immediately the results are released before opening dates of next term. The examinations were as follow

- 1. Registration of July 2024 KNEC exams (ongoing)
- 2. The release of November 2024 KNEC exams on march
- 3. March 2024 KNEC exam and CDACC exams done between 18<sup>th</sup> March 2024 to 9<sup>th</sup> April 2024
- 4. Internal exams / CBET formative exams done between 25th March to 9th April 2024
- 5. CBET summative exams between 25th March to 17th April 2024

The Polytechnic has continued to register positive improvement in all the courses. However, I wish to request your support in encouraging Trainees to work harder and remain focused on their academic goals in order to improve individual performance All trainees are expected to be in their homes immediately after completing their examinations.
