



GOVERNMENT FEES STRUCTURE FOR ALL COURSES

Following your placement in the institution, you are eligible for a Government scholarship, loan and bursary to assist you with your education expenses. In case the Government scholarship, loan and bursary do not cover the cost of your studies, the deficit will be paid by your parent / Guardian.
